Since 1996 Winwick Athletic FC has been providing a football experience for many boys and girls, and has been pioneering with the introduction of our 'U5/U6 Academy' in 1999. From an early stage Winwick Athletic realised the importance of providing safe football for all, using qualified coaches, involving all abilities, thus being a truly open-door Club very proud to operate a genuine equal opportunity policy and to be committed to the prevention of discrimination in any form. From 2004 the Club started its mission to become a Charter Standard Club and was delighted not only to become an FA Charter Standard Development Club in 2006 but also to be awarded the Lancashire County FA and North West Regional FA Development Club of the Year Honour for 2007 and repeat that along with the National Award in 2009, plus NW Regional again in 2011. On 16th Jan 2013 we were the highest level possible of FA Charter Standard Community Club, and on 1st June 2014 we became a Nike Partner Club.

SKILLS & PLAYER DEVELOPMENT.

The FA promotes a national programme of skills coaching sessions aimed at raising the level of grassroots coaching and of ensuring that

all young football players are equipped with basic football skills for their future use and enjoyment. Winwick adheres to this guidance.

TRAINING TIMES/LOCATION

During the "winter" we may train indoors, but usually we will be on the grass every Saturday morning, 8.30am-9.30am at **Winwick Recreation Ground, Winwick Leisure Centre, Myddleton Lane, WA2 8LQ** ([///adjusting.dads.bunkers](http://adjusting.dads.bunkers))

Players when indoors need to wear shin pads and trainers and wear long sleeved tops and jogging pants to avoid friction burns. When outdoors on the grass football boots are required when wet instead of trainers, but the players can wear short sleeved tops and shorts if they wish (weather dependent !!).

Players must have sufficient drinks with them to avoid dehydration and a parent/guardian stay nearby. **Parents are encouraged to become involved, help train the kids and even become a coach themselves.**

FEEES

All players at this age are encouraged to come along for the first 3 weeks free, to see if they

like football with us, and thereafter a weekly fee of £3.00 is charged. This is only payable for sessions that the player actually attends, and money goes into a fund to pay for equipment, new kit when they reach U7s age, plus to pay for free treats like Christmas Parties, etc.

When players move to older age groups at Winwick (from U7 to U16) there is a monthly subscription charge of around £25 / £30 per month, every month of the year, to maintain the necessary funds in the team squad to buy all equipment such as balls, bibs, cones, kits and other training requirements.

PROGRESSION TO UNDER 7'S

Every year the U6 players are generally put into groups and the training can 'split' at some point into separate U5/U6 (Reception) and U6/U7 (Year 1) sessions as the players begin to get ready for matches when they become the new U7 teams from 1st July each year.
